

MoReq2 Change Log

This document records the changes in each version of MoReq2. It is available from <http://www.moreq2.eu>.

SPECIAL NOTE:

Just after we had finished work on this version, we were informed of an inconsistency in the metadata model numbering. The inconsistency is that there are three metadata elements with the reference number M133. This will not affect most users of MoReq2, but may affect users of the metadata model, especially as regards the cross-referencing using metadata element reference number. Hopefully this will be corrected in a later version of MoReq2. The correction will probably involve changing the three elements numbered M133 to M133, M196 and M197 (listing them here in the order they appear in section 9.7 and 9.8.2) – but this is not guaranteed.

We apologise for any inconvenience that this inconsistency may cause.
